### INTENT TO SOLE SOURCE

The South Carolina Department of Health and Environmental Control (DHEC) is seeking qualified vendors to provide a single open system utilizing digital imaging to automate the reading and interpretation of clinical microbiology tests and quality control from various manufactures. System must be customized with optional modules including, but not limited to, antibiotic susceptibility, organism identification, 96-well microtiter, and colony counting, using Kirby Bauer, api strips, Micro Broth Dilution plate, and E-test strip processes. The system must be compatible with Centers for Disease Control Antibiotic Resistant Laboratory Network methodology platforms for testing Carbapenemase Resistant Enterobacteriaceae and Carbapenemase Resistant Pseudomonas aeruginosa. This system is to be used in the DHEC Public Health Laboratory.
