Your facility's coverage under the terms and conditions of this permit shall be effective on April 30, 2015. This letter should be retained with the registration permit.

It is your responsibility to comply with all the requirements of this Registration Permit. The Department may conduct periodic inspections of your facility to determine compliance with the requirements of the Registration Permit. Any violations found during these inspections may result in an enforcement action. Therefore, it is incumbent upon you to ensure you are in compliance with the Registration Permit at all times. It is important for you to read this issued permit carefully and to understand all requirements.
