Enclosed is the General Conditional Major Operating Permit for Concrete Plants ("General Permit") for the above referenced facility. The federally enforceable emissions limitations and operational requirements contained within this General Permit are designed to restrict this facility's potential to emit to below major source thresholds. The permit was issued on June 30, 2011 and will be valid through June 30, 2021. Your facility's coverage under the terms and conditions of this permit begins on November 6, 2013.

It is your responsibility to comply with all the requirements of this General Permit. The Department may conduct periodic inspections of your facility to determine compliance with the requirements of the General Permit. Any violations found during these inspections may result in an enforcement action. Therefore, it is incumbent upon you to ensure you are in compliance with the General Permit at all times. It is important for you to read this issued permit carefully and to understand all requirements. If your facility no longer requires this permit, please submit DHEC Form D-2374 ("Permit Cancellation") to cancel your coverage under the General Permit. If coverage is not cancelled, you are responsible for all annual General Permit fees.

In the event you disagree with the decision to approve the General Permit or the terms and conditions of the General Permit, the enclosed "Guide to Board Review" explains the process for contesting the Department's decision.
