SUBMISSION OF REVISED WORK PLAN AND BUDGET:

The final determination of which counties will be served by a given grantee will be made at the programmatic level.

This is a Notice of Award of grant funds for the FY2016-RFGA-MC-602 and becomes the official statement of award effective 5:00 pm on September 30, 2015 unless otherwise suspended or cancelled.
