Determine your initial licensing fee (\$400 plus \$50 for each additional tattoo station over 8), add \$50 for the Initial Certification Fee and \$350 for the Initial Inspection Fee. This will provide you with the total amount due to our office for an initial license.

Once you have received your initial license, it will be effective for a 12-month period. Afterwards, you will be required to renew your license annually. The renewal license fee is \$400 plus \$50 for each additional tattoo station over 8. There is no certification fee or inspection fee assessed for renewing a license.

In accordance with Section 201.G. of Regulation 61-111, Standards For Licensing Tattoo Facilities; license fees for Tattoo Facilities are determined as follows:

### **LICENSING, INSPECTION AND CERTIFICATION FEES**

License Fee	\$400 plus an additional \$50 for each tattoo workstation over eight - Applicable for Initial Licensing and Annual Licensing Renewals.
Initial Inspection Fee	\$350 - Applicable only for the initial inspection when applying for a license for the first time. An additional \$200 will be charged each time a return visit is required if the facility does not pass the initial inspection.
Certification Fee	\$50 - Applicable only for the initial certification inspection to determine that the new facility is not within 1,000 feet of a church, school, or playground.

### **EXAMPLES OF LICENSING FEES**

Example 1: If the facility has 8 stations or less, then the license fee is the base fee of \$400. (The first eight stations are exempt from the additional \$50 fee)

Example 2: If the facility has 9 stations, then the license fee is \$450. (Nine stations minus the first eight which are exempt equals one; \$400 plus \$50 x 1 station)

Example 3: If the facility has 15 stations, then the license fee would be \$750 (\$400 plus \$50 x 7 stations). 15 Stations minus the number of stations exempt from the \$50 fee (8) equals 7. 7 times \$50 equals \$350, added to the base fee of \$400 equals a total fee of \$750.

**Note:** In each of these examples, if you are applying for a license for the first time, you will need to add \$50 for the initial certification fee and \$350 for the initial inspection fee.
