



About Your New Recycling Roll Cart ...

Once you receive a recycling roll cart, it belongs to you. Please note that the roll cart can **ONLY** be used for recycling.

The roll cart has a 10-year warranty. If it becomes damaged due to a material defect or workmanship, the roll cart can be repaired or replaced at no charge. There is a \$75 fee for a replacement roll cart for any other reason.

If you have a problem with your cart, contact the City of Simpsonville's Public Works Department at **864-967-9531** for repairs or warranty information.

The City of Simpsonville Recycling Drop-off Site ...

A recycling drop-off site is located at the **Public Works Facility** on Woodside Park Drive. It is open Monday through Friday, 7:30 a.m. to 4 p.m.

The **Public Works** site accepts **electronics from households** (televisions, computers, computer monitors, printers and other electronic equipment) and **used motor oil, filters and bottles**.

Curbside Recycling Program ...

To participate in the City of Simpsonville's curbside recycling program, register at City Hall or complete the form on the right. There is a registration fee of \$25 that includes the cost of your new 96-gallon recycling roll cart.



Recycling Collection Schedule ...

Recyclables will be collected each week on your regular garbage collection day (except holidays when collection will be on the next business day).

	ITEMS ACCEPTED FOR CURBSIDE RECYCLING	HOW TO RECYCLE
	ALUMINUM CANS	Please rinse.
	BOOKS (paperback ONLY)	Keep dry. Do not bag or tie.
	CARDBOARD	Keep dry.
	GLASS JARS AND BOTTLES (clear, green, brown)	Please rinse. Do not break.
	NEWSPAPER, INSERTS AND MAGAZINES	Keep dry. Do not bag or tie.
	OFFICE PAPER	Keep dry. Do not bag or tie.
	PAPERBOARD (e.g., cereal boxes, shoe boxes)	Keep dry.
	PLASTIC BOTTLES, JUGS AND JARS	Please rinse.
	STEEL/METAL CANS	Please rinse.
	UNWANTED MAIL	Keep dry. Do not bag or tie.
