Dear Mr. Poudrier:

Available information indicates that JT's Chrysler Jeep Dodge has permanently ceased all production operations at the 5215 Sunset Blvd location in Lexington, South Carolina. In consideration of this and pursuant to the provisions of the *Pollution Control Act*, Sections 48-1-50(5) and 48-1-110(a), the *1976 Code of Laws of South Carolina*, as amended, and *South Carolina Regulation 61-62, Air Pollution Control Regulations and Standards*, the South Carolina Department of Health and Environmental Control (Department) hereby notifies you that all permits (construction permits, state operating permit, and any other permits) previously issued by the Bureau of Air Quality are hereby canceled and considered null and void.

In accordance with the South Carolina Regulation 61-62.1, "Any person who plans to construct, alter, or add to a source of air contaminants, including installation of any device for the control of air contaminant discharges, shall first obtain a construction permit from the Department." Therefore, from this date forward, any person who intends to operate at this site must first obtain all necessary permits.
