NOTICE OF A PROPOSED SIGNIFICANT MODIFICATION TO AN EXISTING PART 70 AIR QUALITY (TITLE V OPERATING) PERMIT

THREE RIVERS LANDFILL 9900 ATOMIC ROAD (HIGHWAY 125) JACKSON, SOUTH CAROLINA (AIKEN COUNTY / REGION 5 AIKEN EQC OFFICE) AIR PERMIT NO. TV-0080-0112

Three Rivers Landfill has applied to the SC DHEC for a significant modification to their existing Part 70 Air Quality (Title V Operating) Permit for its existing facility. Draft Revised Title V Operating Permit and Statement of Basis have been written by the BAQ incorporating and outlining the proposed project and applicable regulations. The draft revised permit includes the following:

- To update conditions in the permit to allow for the following: a) landfill gas collection (LFG) control system device b) increase operating temperatures c) update attachment B and d) correct Attachment C.

If approved, the draft revised Title V Operating Permit will enable the facility to continue to operate as a major source in accordance with SC DHEC Regulation 61-62.70 "Title V Operating Permit Program." All emissions limitations and conditions contained in the draft revised permit have been written to ensure that the facility operates within the requirements of the Title V Operating Permit Program for the State of South Carolina. The draft revised permit has not yet been approved and is open to comment from the public and the United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA).

Interested persons may review the materials drafted and maintained by DHEC for this facility and submit written comments on the draft permit by July 31, 2009, to Karen Lee at the above DHEC address or by e-mail at leeka@dhec.sc.gov. Where there is a significant amount of public interest, DHEC may hold a public hearing to receive additional comments. Public hearing requests should be made in writing to Karen Lee at the above DHEC address or by e-mail. If a public hearing is requested and scheduled, notice will be given in this newspaper thirty (30) days in advance. If you have questions concerning the draft permit please contact Wanda Parnell at the phone number listed above. A final review request (appeal) may be filed after a permit decision has been made.
