Ms. Lee,

I would like to register for the public hearing and/or meeting regarding the above emissions permit for Jones-Hamilton in Chester County, SC.

I am not necessarily opposed to JH locating 3 miles from my family's property, but I am opposed to adding more corporate air pollution to Chester County without installing air monitoring stations to more accurately monitor the air we breathe in our county. With abnormally high lung and other cancer rates in our county, reliance on air monitoring stations outside of Chester County fails to accurately measure the toxic chemicals being emitted into our air which could potentially be the reason for these high cancer rates. As you likely are aware, emissions in Chester County would be dispersed considerably by the time those emissions reach these outside monitoring stations, not to mention making it more difficult to pinpoint the origin of those emissions and concentrations.

As I said, I am not opposed to JH locating in Chester County, as my research on the company would appear to indicate a responsible corporate citizen, but without DHEC installing air monitoring stations in Chester County to protect our citizens health, I must oppose the emissions permit being requested by JH at this time.
