Please be advised that DHEC has made a decision regarding the permit after consideration and complete review of the following: applicable state and federal air quality regulations, your comments received within the required time frame, and all other pertinent information. All comments received were reviewed for technical merit and have been included in DHEC's permanent record for this facility. DHEC has concluded that the issues raised and comments made do not legally prevent issuance of the permit. Therefore, DHEC's decision is to approve Santee Cooper Winyah Generating Station permit for issuance on, Thursday, October 2, 2014.
