The South Carolina Department of Health and Environmental Control (the Department) hereby notifies the public that it has reviewed the application for a new Class 2 Landfill and has determined that the proposed landfill is consistent with the requirements set forth in Regulation 61-107.19 for Class 2 landfills. The Department has prepared a draft permit that reflects an annual disposal limit for the proposed Appleton Class 2 Landfill of 21,000 tons. The draft permit and permit application are available to the public for review and comment.
