

## INTENT TO MINE

Willow Oak Quarry, LLC has applied to the S.C. Department of Health and Environmental Control (SCDHEC) for a permit to mine granite in South Carolina (Application I-001900). A proposed reclamation plan has been submitted indicating the site will be restored to lake and grassland after mining. The proposed mine is located in Kershaw County approximately 2.6 miles north/ northwest of Westville, South Carolina. Specifically the site is located 0.8 miles west of the junction of U.S. Highway 521/ 601 and SC Secondary Highway S-28-498 (Sawmill Road). Specifically the site is located north of Sawmill Road between its two junctions with Quarry Road (unpaved road).
