PUBLIC NOTICE**

Topic: Proposed Vertical Expansion of the WCA Shiloh Construction, Demolition and Land-Clearing Debris Landfill

Location: The landfill entrance is located at 223 Rock Quarry Road, Travelers Rest, SC 29690

The South Carolina Department of Health and Environmental Control (SCDHEC) - Solid Waste Permitting Section has received a permit application from WCA Shiloh Landfill, LLC for a vertical expansion of its existing Construction, Demolition and Land-Clearing Debris (C&D) Landfill. The proposed vertical expansion increases the landfill height from elevation 1070 to elevation 1248 feet above sea level.

SCDHEC requires that a permit be issued for C&D landfill expansions pursuant to SC Code Ann. Sections 44-96-10 et. seq. (Supp. 2006) and 25A SC Code Reg. 61-107.11: Construction, Demolition and Land-Clearing Debris Landfills (Supp. 2006). The types of waste accepted by the WCA Shiloh landfill are limited to Appendix I of the above-mentioned regulation. Acceptable wastes include, but are not limited to, land-clearing debris, bricks, blocks, shingles, lumber, and other wastes listed in Appendix I that have not been in contact with lead-based paint, hazardous constituents, or petroleum products. Wastes that are not acceptable at C&D landfills include household garbage, hazardous waste, and infectious waste. At this time, the Solid Waste Permitting Section has completed an administrative review of the permit application and found that all required documents are in place to begin a technical review.
