**ADOPTION OF NEW BEACHFRONT JURISDICTIONAL LINES
HARBOR ISLAND, HUNTING ISLAND, FRIPP ISLAND,
ST. PHILLIPS ISLAND, PRITCHARDS ISLAND, LITTLE CAPERS ISLAND,
BAY POINT ISLAND, DAUFUSKIE ISLAND
BEAUFORT COUNTY**

In accordance with Section 48-39-280(C) of the Coastal Zone Management Act, DHEC has analyzed scientific data and considered public comments on the proposed new beachfront jurisdictional lines for Harbor Island, Hunting Island, Fripp Island, St. Phillips Island, Pritchards Island, Little Capers Island, Bay Point Island, and Daufuskie Island.

After careful evaluation, DHEC has made the following conclusions:

- Harbor Island: No change from jurisdictional lines proposed in May 2009.
- Hunting Island: No change from jurisdictional lines proposed in May 2009.
- Fripp Island: No change from jurisdictional lines proposed in May 2009.
- St. Phillips Island: No change from jurisdictional lines proposed in May 2009.
- Pritchards Island: No change from jurisdictional lines proposed in May 2009.
- Little Capers Island: No change from jurisdictional lines proposed in May 2009.
- Bay Point Island: No change from jurisdictional lines proposed in May 2009.
- Daufuskie Island. No change from jurisdictional lines proposed in August 2009.
