## Preamble

The Clean Water Act requires that states develop a list of potential projects to be funded from the Clean Water State Revolving Fund (CWSRF) and rank them in priority order. The following is a comprehensive list of potential projects. These projects have been listed in priority order based on a document developed by DHEC entitled *Integrated Priority Ranking System for Wastewater and Nonpoint Source Projects* (IPRS), which is located on the DHEC web site <http://www.scdhec.net/water/pubs/prscw.pdf>. Only those projects that appear on this list are may be considered for a loan under the CWSRF Program.

In general, to be placed on the list, an eligible project sponsor must complete and submit to DHEC a Project Questionnaire. A copy of this questionnaire may be found on DHEC's website at <http://www.scdhec.net/water/forms/d-3561.pdf>. Prior to completing the questionnaire the project sponsor should first review carefully the ranking system outlined in the IPRS. A prospective SRF project sponsor may submit a completed questionnaire for a project at any time.

DHEC's web site is the primary public-notice medium for the Priority List. DHEC will update the list as project questionnaires are received and post it on the web site at <http://www.scdhec.net/water/pubs/cwpriority.pdf>. Interested parties are invited to review and submit written comments on the posted Priority List at any time during the year. Prospective SRF sponsors are asked to take such opportunities to review their projects closely, and to notify the Department in writing of any that should be deleted or modified.
