

**IDEA PART C (BabyNet) PERFORMANCE DETERMINATIONS  
FFY 2007-FFY 2009**

(July 1, 2006 – December 31, 2009)

DHEC administrative regions were designated Part C “early intervention service” (EIS) agencies for the BabyNet program through December 31, 2009 while DHEC served as lead agency.

The IDEA Part C lead agency is required to assess performance of each EIS agency and to make one of the following “determinations” annually:

- Meets Requirements
- Needs Assistance
- Needs Intervention
- Needs substantial intervention

The tables below include resulting determinations by year since this requirement was made, information about how the determinations were calculated, and follow up actions are included in subsequent tables.
