



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- A flu shot should be taken every year.

- Those at high risk are especially encouraged to get their shots:
 - Elderly
 - Those with diabetes
 - Those with heart disease
 - Those with long term or chronic illness

Medicare Part B pays for flu and pneumonia shots. Check with your local public health department or health care provider.



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
