

What is “Spare the Air South Carolina?”

Spare the Air South Carolina is an initiative of the S.C. Department of Health and Environmental Control to partner with employers in the state to implement voluntary programs that help improve air quality. This includes informational tools about commute options such as carpooling; as well as tools to reduce emissions through example policies, retro-fitting diesel engines, and activities to increase employees’ awareness of air quality issues in South Carolina.

Spare the Air South Carolina engages employers in the effort to improve air quality by providing them with tools to help their employees take control of their commutes, and by offering alternative commute ideas and information to reduce emissions produced by vehicles and other sources of air pollution. All employers from across South Carolina are encouraged to participate in these programs.

Spare the Air South Carolina is helping to:

- Improve and enhance the state’s air quality.
- Provide a low to no cost transportation benefit to employees.
- Educate employees on the health and environmental benefits of reducing mobile source emissions.
- Offer information about low or no cost transportation alternatives to employers.
