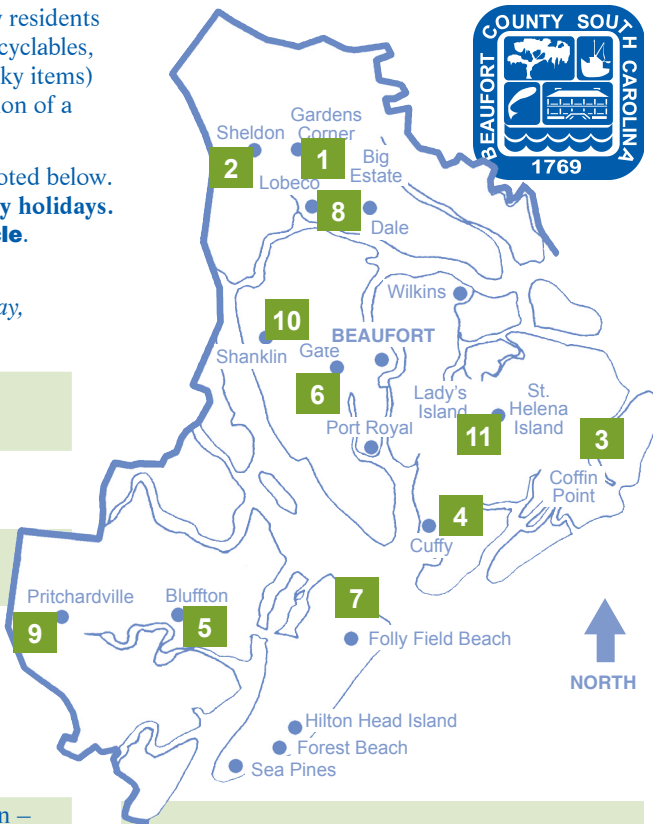

## More to Know ...

**COMMERCIAL SOLID WASTE:** The use of any Beaufort County Convenience Center for the disposal of commercially generated waste is **strictly forbidden** and is considered illegal dumping. **NO burn barrels** may be dumped.

**C&D DEBRIS:** Small amounts (two pickup loads) of residential C&D debris can be taken to Beaufort County Convenience Centers. Residents can take large quantities of C&D debris to Oakwood Landfill in Ridgeland. Ask convenience center attendants for directions.

**OIL/GASOLINE MIXTURE (RED TANKS):** Accepted fluids include motor, gear, heating and fuel oils, oil/gasoline mixture, diesel fuel and kerosene as well as automotive transmission, steering and hydraulic fluids.

**OYSTER SHELLS:** Oyster shells are collected at the Beaufort County Public Works location on Shanklin Road, the St. Helena Convenience Center, the Sands in Port Royal, Hunting Island, Trask Landing and Edgar Glenn. Dump the loose shells in the collection area. No bags, please.

**SPECIAL WASTE:** Electronic scrap and hazardous household waste are taken at scheduled events. For a list of upcoming collection dates, please visit [www.bcgov.net/recycle](http://www.bcgov.net/recycle).

**ALL MATERIAL** brought to convenience centers is limited to one pick-up truck or one trailer (measuring 5 feet by 8 feet). Limit two loads per person per day.

**USED MOTOR OIL TANKS:** The following petroleum products **ARE NOT ACCEPTED** in used oil collection tanks at Beaufort County Convenience Centers – varsol, brake fluid, paint thinner, refrigeration oil, antifreeze and solvent, cleaner or any substance used to clean paint brushes. Call **(843) 255-2736** for disposal options.

**YARD TRIMMINGS** in larger amounts must be taken to the Oakwood Landfill.

**COVER YOUR LOAD!** An uncovered or spilling load from your vehicle is a violation of S.C. law and is subject to fines.
