The Department has renewed the Bureau of Air Quality's General Conditional Major Operating Permit for Asphalt Plants ("General Permit"). The renewed permit was issued on July 15, 2013 and will be valid through June 30, 2018. This permit supersedes any previous construction and/or operating permit issued to your facility. Your facility's coverage under the terms and conditions of this permit begins on August 5, 2013.

A copy of the General Permit and your facility's attachment(s) are enclosed with this letter. It is your responsibility to comply with all the requirements of this General Permit. The Department may conduct periodic inspections of your facility to determine compliance with the requirements of the General Permit. Any violations found during these inspections may result in an enforcement action. Therefore, it is incumbent upon you to ensure you are in compliance with the General Permit at all times. It is important for you to read this issued permit carefully and to understand all requirements. If your facility no longer requires this permit, please submit DHEC Form D-2374 ("Permit Cancellation / Temporary Closure") to cancel your coverage under the General Permit. If coverage is not cancelled, you are responsible for all annual General Permit fees.

In the event, you disagree with the decision to approve the General Permit, or the terms and conditions of the General Permit, the enclosed "Guide to Board Review" explains the process for contesting the Department's decision.
