- I. **TITLE:** Administrative and Consent Orders issued by Environmental Quality Control ("EQC").
- II. **SUBJECT:** Administrative, Consent and Environmental Health Orders issued by EQC during the period April 1, 2011 April 30, 2011.
- III. **FACTS:** For the periods April 1, 2011 through April 30, 2011, EQC issued twenty-six (26) Consent Orders with total assessed civil penalties in the amount of \$73,313.00 and two (2) Environmental Health Orders with total assessed penalties in the amount of \$750.00. Also, one (1) Administrative Order was issued during the reporting period with a civil penalty assessed in the amount of \$2,610.00.

Unless otherwise specified, "Previous Orders" as listed in this report include orders issued by Environmental Quality Control programs within the last five (5) years.

ANALYSIS: During the reporting period, Underground Storage Tank Enforcement issued an Administrative Order against Pasley and Sons Variety Store (Respondent) owner and operator of underground storage tanks. The Respondent has violated the SC Underground Storage Tank Control Regulations for failure to have the corrosion protection system inspected by a qualified tester every three (3) years; failure to provide records upon request; and, failure to pay annual registration fees. To comply with the Order, the Respondent must submit a corrosion protection system test and pay the annual registration fees for fiscal years 2010 and 2011 in the amount of seven hundred twenty six dollars (\$726.00). A civil penalty in the amount of two thousand six hundred and ten dollars (\$2,610.00) was assessed.

Water Pollution Enforcement entered into eight (8) Consent Orders during the reporting period. Of those 8 orders, five (5) were for not submitting an administratively complete application for renewal of their National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) General Permit for Utility Water Discharges within 180 days prior to expiration. Total civil penalties assessed for the 5 orders was four thousand five hundred dollars (\$4,500.00)

Air Quality Enforcement entered into four (4) Consent Orders with four (4) Respondents, EMS Demolition and Abatement, LLC; Semper Fi Constructors, LLC; Balfour Beatty Construction, LLC; and, Geo-Systems Design and Testing, Inc. for work conducted at a building located at Fort Jackson, South Carolina. The Respondents were contracted to manage the demolition and renovation of several projects at the U.S. Army Garrison and failed to obtain proper permits; failed to conduct building inspections; failed to dispose of the asbestos containing material properly; and, failed to take the proper samples of the asbestos containing material. Civil penalties assessed for the Respondents totaled twenty-four thousand eight hundred dollars (\$24,300.00).
