failed to perform the required tests for particulate matter emissions every two years.

Action: The Individual/Entity is required to: henceforth ensure that the facility-wide best management practice plan, including all record keeping, is implemented pursuant to the operating permit; conduct the required tests for particulate matter emissions every two years; and, pay a civil penalty in the amount of nine thousand, eight hundred fifty-three dollars (\$9,853.00).
