- II. **SUBJECT:** Administrative and Consent Orders issued during the period September 1, 2010 September 30, 2010.
- III. **FACTS:** For the periods September 1, 2010 through September 30, 2010, EQC issued twenty-four (24) Consent Orders with total assessed civil penalties in the amount of \$113,952.00. One (1) Administrative Order was also reported during this period with total assessed civil penalties in the amount of \$23,000.00.

Unless otherwise specified, "Previous Orders" as listed in this report include orders issued by Environmental Quality Control programs within the last five (5) years.

ANALYSIS: During the reporting period, Solid Waste Enforcement issued an Administrative Order against James C. Westbrook (Respondent). The Respondent engaged in open dumping on property located on Ashley River Road in Dorchester County. Violations

include the dumping of waste tires and miscellaneous solid waste at the property. To comply with the Order, the Respondent must remove all waste tires and solid waste and submit disposal and/or recycling receipts. A civil penalty in the amount of twenty three thousand dollars (\$23,000.00) was assessed.

Water Pollution Enforcement entered into Consent Orders with four (4) utilities that are operators of wastewater treatment facilities (WWTF) for various violations. Total civil penalties were assessed for the 4 orders in the amount of thirteen thousand, one hundred and eight dollars (\$13,108.00).

Air Quality Enforcement entered into seven (7) Consent Orders with various respondents. Of those seven, three (3) were for asbestos related violations with civil penalties assessed in the amount of twenty-two thousand (\$22,000.00) and three (3) were issued for open burning violations with civil penalties assessed in the amount of thirteen thousand dollars (13,000.00).
