III. FACT: For the period July 1, 2007, through July 31, 2007, Health Regulation issued one (1) sanction letter, one license suspension and two (2) Consent Orders with total penalties of \$5,750.

IV. ANALYSIS: 1. Rapha Residential Care, 3959 Fish Hatchery Road, Gaston, SC 29053. Under a Consent Order dated July 25, 2007, the facility paid a penalty of \$4,250. The facility was found to have violated R.61-84, Standards for Licensing Community Residential Care Facilities for failure to provide a written reply to the Department's Report of Visit; a care plan was not updated addressing prevention of elopement; and residents known as elopement risks were not monitored for repeat elopement.

Previous Sanctions: None

2. <u>Palmetto Residential Care of North Charleston, 2834 Spruill Avenue, North Charleston, SC 29405</u>. On October 13, 2006, the Department issued a letter to suspend the facility's license; however, on July 9, 2007, the Department lifted the suspension because the facility had complied satisfactorily. The facility was found to have violated R.61-84, <u>Standards for Licensing Community Residential Care Facilities</u> for failure to meet the requirements of its twenty-four (24) month plan for bringing the facility into compliance with current building and life safety codes.

Previous Sanctions: None.

3. Oakleaf at Thornblade, 11560 Thornblade Blvd., Greer, SC 29650. On May 3, 2007, the facility was issued a Sanction Letter and paid a penalty of penalty of \$500. The facility was found to have violated R.61-84, Standards for Licensing Community Residential Care Facilities for failure to remit assessed late fees and acceptable evacuation plans.

Previous Sanctions: None

4. <u>GS-2 Engineering and Environmental Consultants, Inc., 4301 Dorchester Road, Unit #2, Charleston, SC 29405</u>. Under a Consent Order dated May 24, 2007, the facility paid a penalty of \$1,000. The facility was found to have violated R.61-63, <u>Radioactive Materials</u>, for failure to maintain leak test inventory records and records of individual monitoring results as required.
