IV. ANALYSIS: 1. Rainbow Emporium, 310 South Nichols Street, Nichols, SC 29582. By letter dated August 28, 2007, the Department notified Rainbow Emporium that its permit as a body piercing facility would not be renewed. The Department did not receive a reply from the establishment. The establishment was found to have violated R.61-109, Standards for Licensing Body Piercing Facilities and State Budget Proviso 9.18 for failure to submit a permit application with application fee and failure to submit two late fees.

Previous Sanctions: None

2. <u>Countryside Healthcare, 706 Pelzer Highway, Easley, SC 29307 and Skylyn Health Center, 1705 Skylyn Drive, Spartanburg, SC 29307.</u> Under a Consent Order dated August 28, 2007, Emeritus Corporation, owner of the purchasing entities of the two (2) aforementioned facilities, paid a fine of \$15,000. The facilities were found to be in violation of R.61-15, <u>Certification of Need for Health Facilities and Services</u>. Violations include failure to obtain a determination from the Department concerning a change of ownership.

Previous Sanctions: None

3. <u>Backhome Care Facility</u>, 140 <u>Checkerberry Court</u>, <u>Eutawville</u>, <u>SC 29048</u>. By letter dated August 17, 2006, the facility's license was suspended. The license was reinstated on August 30, 2007, when the facility paid a \$1500 penalty fee. The facility was found to be in violation of Regulation 61-84, <u>Standards for Licensing Community</u>

	<u>Residential Care Facilities</u> for failure to submit required documents for facility building/safety compliance and processing a change of licensee.
