- I. TITLE: Administrative Orders, Consent Orders, and Sanction Letters issued by HEALTH REGULATION (HR).
- II. SUBJECT: Sanctions completed during the period November 1, 2008, through November 30, 2008.
- III. FACT: For the period November 1, 2008, through November 30, 2008, Health Regulation issued four (4) Consent Orders with total penalties of \$17,500.

IV. ANALYSIS: 1. <u>Unlicensed Community Residential Care Facility</u>, 3750 Sheminally Road, <u>Pamplico</u>, SC 29583. Under a Consent Order dated August 20, 2008, the facility paid a civil penalty of \$2,500. The facility was found to have violated <u>R.61-84</u>, <u>Standards for Licensing Community Residential Care Facilities</u>. Violations included: operation of an unlicensed community residential care facility.

Previous Sanctions: None

2. Fountainside Eldercare Inn, 709 Quillen Avenue, Fountain Inn, SC 29644. Under a Consent Order dated July 7, 2008, the facility paid a civil penalty of \$9,500. The facility was found to have violated R.61-84, Standards for Licensing Community Residential Care Facilities. Violations included: failure to pay utility bills in a timely manner; lack of documentation for staff job descriptions, required staff trainings, patient transfers, medication administration review, discharge data; and failure to have exit doors to Alzheimer's Unit release when fire alarm system activated.

<u>Previous Sanctions:</u> February 2, 2006 and January 19, 2007 - Suspension of license for failure to complete requirements of its twenty-four month plan: proper sprinkling of facility.

3. <u>Mamie's Adult Group Homes, Inc. #2, 207 General Dennis Drive, Summerville, SC 29483</u>. Under a Consent Order dated July 16, 2008, the facility paid a fine of \$4,500.00. The facility was found to have violated R.61-84, Standards for Licensing Community Residential Care Facilities for repeat violations: staff records lacked documentation of multiple required trainings; lack of properly prepared Individual Care Plans and Resident Medication Records, etc.

Previous Sanctions: None

4. <u>South Carolina Electric & Gas, Cope Generating Station, 405 Teamwork Road, Cope, SC 29038</u>. Under Consent Order dated August 19, 2008, the facility paid a penalty of \$1,000.00. The facility was found to have violated <u>R.61-63</u>, <u>Radioactive Materials</u> by not properly disposing of devices containing radioactive material.
