IV. ANALYSIS: 1. <u>Aggression Studios</u>, 3403 <u>South Murray Avenue</u>, <u>Anderson</u>, <u>SC 29624</u>. By letter dated March 17, 2009, the Department notified the applicant that its license would not be renewed. The facility was found to have violated <u>R.61-109</u>, <u>Standards for Permitting Body Piercing Facilities (Supp.2008)</u>. Violations included: failure to submit proper license application and fees.

Previous Sanctions: None

2. Palmetto Senior Adult Day Care, 1403 East Greenville Street, Suite D, Anderson, SC 29621. By letter dated March 17, 2009, the Department notified the applicant that its license would not be renewed. The facility was found to have violated R.61-84, Standards for Licensing Community Residential Care Facilities. Violations included: failure to submit proper license application and fees.

Previous Sanctions: None

3. <u>Willowglen Academy South Carolina, 1399 Harmony Camp Rd., Greeleyville, SC 29056</u>. Under a Consent Order dated March 9, 2009, the facility agreed to construct a new facility. The existing facility, which

converted from a High Management Group Home to a Residential Treatment Facility (RTF), did not meet the physical plant standards of an RTF. With the execution of the Consent Order, which included a construction timeframe, the Department was able to issue the facility's initial license as an RTF. The facility was found to have violated <u>R.61-103</u>, <u>Standards for Licensing Residential Treatment Facilities for Children and Adolescents</u>. Violations included: failure to meet construction standards.

Previous Sanctions: None

4. Excalibur Youth Services, LLC, 840 SE Main Street, Simpsonville SC 29609. Under a Consent Order dated March 4, 2009, the facility paid \$1,950 of a \$5,850 civil penalty. Payment of the remaining \$3,900 shall be stayed upon one (1) year of good performance with no further violations of R. 61-15. The facility was found to have violated R.61-15, Certification of Need for Health Facilities and Services. Violations included: failure to receive a Certificate of Need prior to setting up beds for patient use.

Previous Sanctions: None

5. <u>Palmetto Endoscopy Center LLC (PEC)</u>, 2073 Charlie Hall Blvd., Charleston, SC 29414. Under a Consent Order dated February 17, 2009, the facility paid a \$22,500 civil penalty. The facility was found to have violated <u>R.61-15</u>, Certification of Need for Health Facilities and Services. Violations included: failure to receive a determination for a change of ownership.

Previous Sanctions: None

6. Nathaniel F. Wilson, Williamsburg Federal Correctional Institution, P. S. Box 340, Salters, SC 29590. Under a Revocation Order dated February 26, 2009, the individual was notified that his Emergency Medical Technician-Paramedic Certificate had been revoked. The individual was found to have violated R.61-7, Emergency Medical Services. Violations included being found guilty of a felony involving moral turpitude, drugs, or gross immorality.
