

Because of your failure to comply with activities required by the South Carolina UST Control Regulations, the UST Program will perform <u>some</u> activities on your behalf to protect human health and the environment. These activities will consist of conducting a limited site assessment to determine if a release of regulated substances has occurred and emptying the USTs of liquids if required. The assessment will consist of the installation of one ground-water monitoring well, analysis of one ground-water sample and one soil sample for petroleum constituents, and a receptor survey.

You will be provided a copy of the reports upon completion of the work. The estimated cost for conducting a site assessment is \$825.00. The estimated base cost for emptying the USTs of all liquids is approximately \$600.00 plus an additional charge for each gallon of liquid. At a future date, you will be billed for the costs incurred.

Please complete and return the enclosed Right-of-Entry form to my attention on or before June 14, 2005. Please note that after the UST Program performs the activities noted above, you are still required to perform all activities required by the South Carolina Underground Storage Tank Control Regulations. As such, DHEC's performance of the above-listed activities is not a waiver of its legal rights to seek enforcement of any Orders related to this matter.

In the event you do not grant the UST Program right-of-entry to the site, the UST Program will seek to obtain an Inspection Warrant to gain access to the site to perform the activities noted above.



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


