The Department conducted an investigation on February 14, 2020, due to Chester County Litter Enforcement contacting the Department about dumping of domestic wastewater from a pump truck. The Individual/Entity has violated the South Carolina Onsite Wastewater (OSWW) Systems Regulation as follows: failed to ensure that no septic tank effluent, domestic wastewater, or sewage was discharged to the surface of the ground without an appropriate permit from the Department.

<u>Action</u>: The Individual/Entity is required to operate in accordance with all applicable requirements of S.C. Code Ann. Regs. 61-56 and 61-56.1, including insuring that all septage is disposed of only at facilities approved by the Department; and pay a civil penalty in the amount of one thousand dollars (**\$1,000.00**).
