
South Carolina's Family Planning

You can receive quality health care at
affordable rates. Your rate is based
on a sliding fee scale and you pay
according to your income, family size,
and insurance.

Family Planning Preventive Health services include pap smears according to screening guidelines, providing birth control services as requested, dispensing emergency contraception, pregnancy testing, abstinence education, sexually transmitted infections (STI) screenings and treatment, and much more.






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### **Services Provided:**

- Birth Control Available on Site
- Low or No-cost Services for Women, Men and Teens
- Reproductive Health Education
- Pregnancy Testing
- STI Testing, Treatment and Counseling
- HIV Risk Assessment (education, counseling and testing)
- Assistance with applying to Medicaid (If applicable and eligible)





## **Birth Control Methods:**

Clients who are at-risk of an unintended pregnancy, are offered a broad range of prescription and nonprescription medically approved birth control methods to include, but not limited to:

- Instruction in Abstinence
- Hormonal and Non-Hormonal Birth Control
- Pills, IUD, Implant, Depo, Patch and Ring
- Barrier Birth Control (condoms)
- Instruction in Natural Family Planning Methods
- Permanent Methods of Birth Control for Women and Men available to clients 21 or over (following strict federal regulations)
