**Subject:** Licensed Midwives Regulation Revision

The Department is seeking individuals who would like to participate in a regulation revision workshop for Licensed Midwives. The meeting will be composed of the Midwifery Advisory Council, Licensed Midwives, and stakeholders from throughout the state, as well as Department representatives. The Department initiated the statutory process to revise Regulation 61-24, Licensed Midwives, by publication of a Notice of Drafting (NOD) in the *State Register* August 28, 2015. The goal of this meeting is to have an open dialogue about the issues pertaining to Licensed Midwives and the revision of R.61-24.

The meeting will be held Tuesday, September 15, 2015, at 3:30 p.m. at the Columbia Mills Building located at 301 Gervais Street, Columbia, South Carolina 29201. Upon arrival, proceed to the rear of the building and enter through the glass doors under the blue awning.
