**SUBJECT:** Examination to Establish Eligibility for Licensure as a Hearing Aid Specialist

The written examination to establish eligibility for licensure to fit and sell hearing aids within the State of South Carolina will be administered on **Tuesday, March 11, 2014**, at 301 Gervais St., Columbia, SC.

If you intend to take the written examination, the following items must be received in this office by **February 6, 2014**: (1) a completed application; (2) a \$95.00 fee; and (3) all phased training reports, I-V (if you hold a temporary permit). **If these items are not received by this date, you will not be allowed to take the examination.**

A study guide prepared by the International Hearing Society is available online at [www.scdhec.sc.gov/health/licen/](http://www.scdhec.sc.gov/health/licen/). The menu item is Hearing Aid License. Those who pass the written examination will be able to take the practical examination on May 6, 2014.
