HOURS OF OPERATION:

All Fairfield County Recycling Centers are **OPEN** Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, Friday and Saturday from 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. as well as Sunday from 2 p.m. to 6 p.m. All centers are **CLOSED** on Wednesday.



How do I recycle in Fairfield County?

Recycling is easy in Fairfield County. The county has 10 recycling centers for residents to use. All you have to do is keep your recyclable items separate from your garbage.

When you take your recyclables to a recycling center, put them into the recycling containers labeled for each item. If you have any questions about where to put your recyclables or what can be recycled, ask a center attendant.

Why should I recycle?

Waste reduction and recycling can save money. Recycling reduces the amount of money needed to build and maintain landfills as well as the transportation costs to get the garbage there.

In some ways, recycling can make money. Fairfield County has a new processing facility for recyclables. It helps the county market recycled materials to businesses that use them to make new products. The money made from the sale of these recyclables is used to fund the county's solid waste program and, in turn, saves money for all Fairfield County residents.

Remember that recycling saves landfill space, natural resources and creates jobs, too. Recycling is a great way to help protect the environment.

Reduce & reuse, too.

- **REDUCE PAPER USAGE** – Use both sides of the paper. Use cloth towels instead of paper ones. Sign up to pay your bills on-line.
- **COMPOST FOOD SCRAPS AND YARD TRIMMINGS** – Leave grass clippings on your lawn where they decompose quickly and add nutrients. To receive the FREE booklet, "Home Composting Made Easy," call **1-800-768-7348**.
- **SHOP SMART** – Buy products in bulk containers such as dog food, cereal and paper products. Buy concentrates with less packaging such as detergents and cleaners. Buy products and packaging that can be recycled in your community. In short, buy only what you need and use what you buy.

ALUMINUM	Food and beverage cans, foil and clean "pie" plates	Rinse and flatten.	All Recycling Centers
APPLIANCES	See SCRAP METAL		
BATTERIES, LEAD-ACID	Batteries from automobiles, boats, motorcycles, lawn mowers, etc.	NO alkaline batteries.	All Recycling Centers
CARDBOARD	Corrugated cardboard boxes (no wax finish) and paper bags; NO pizza boxes; NO paperboard boxes (e.g., cereal boxes, shoe boxes, etc.)	Flatten. Keep items dry.	All Recycling Centers
COOKING OIL		See the attendant on duty for instructions.	All Recycling Centers
FARMER OIL	Oil from farm equipment	Limit 55 gallons per visit.	Winnsboro and Mitford Recycling Centers
GASOLINE/OIL MIXTURES		Limit 5 gallons per visit.	Winnsboro, Lake Wateree and Monticello Recycling Centers
GLASS	Clear, green and brown glass bottles and jars	Rinse. Window glass, pottery, porcelain and china ARE NOT accepted for disposal.	All Recycling Centers
MOTOR OIL	Used motor oil, kerosene, power steering fluid, diesel fuel, automatic transmission fluid and hydraulic fluid	Oil must be free of gasoline or diesel fuel. Limit five gallons per visit.	All Recycling Centers
MOTOR OIL BOTTLES	See PLASTIC BOTTLES, JARS AND JUGS		
MOTOR OIL FILTERS			All Recycling Centers
NEWSPAPERS	Newspapers and glossy inserts	DO NOT tie or bag.	All Recycling Centers
PAINT, LATEX	Household latex paint – usable quantities ONLY	Paint buckets must have original labels with lids securely fastened.	All Recycling Centers
PAPERBOARD	Packaging cartons for food (cereal, sodas, etc.), and household items		All Recycling Centers
PLASTIC BOTTLES, JARS AND JUGS	Plastic containers (for food, beverage, household products such as shampoo, laundry and cleaning products); NO tubs, bags, film or Styrofoam.	Discard lids and caps. Rinse and flatten all EXCEPT motor oil bottles. Oil bottles must be drained properly overnight.	All Recycling Centers
SCRAP METAL	Appliances, stoves, washers and dryers, refrigerators, grills, bicycles, etc.		All Recycling Centers
TELEPHONE BOOKS			All Recycling Centers
TIRES	Car, motorcycle, bus and truck tires	Remove rims. Limit four tires per visit.	All Recycling Centers
YARD TRIMMINGS	Tree limbs, leaves, Christmas trees, etc. NO stumps, large logs or treated lumber.	Bag or cover items to take to a recycling center; empty bags at the recycling center.	All Recycling Centers
