Enclosed is a modified Registration Permit for Crematory Operations ("Registration Permit"). The modified permit is being issued to incorporate changes into the existing Registration Permit as described in the Record of Revisions. Please note the conditions, emissions limitations, and operational requirements contained within this permit. This letter should be retained with the Registration Permit.

It is your responsibility to comply with all the requirements of this Registration Permit. The Department may conduct periodic inspections of your facility to determine compliance with the requirements of the Registration Permit. Any violations found during these inspections may result in an enforcement action. Therefore, it is incumbent upon you to ensure you are in compliance with the Registration Permit at all times. It is important for you to read this issued permit carefully and to understand all requirements. If your facility no longer requires this permit, please submit DHEC Form D-2374 ("Permit Cancellation") to cancel your coverage under the Registration Permit. If coverage is not cancelled, you are responsible for all annual Registration Permit fees.

In the event, you disagree with the decision to approve the Registration Permit, or the terms and conditions of the Registration Permit, the enclosed "Guide to Board Review" explains the process for contesting the Department's decision.
