Dear Concerned Citizen,

Thank you for your interest and/or comments regarding the request by AVX Corporation to renew their Title V Operating Permit at its existing facility located at 801 17th Avenue South in Myrtle Beach, South Carolina. Please be advised that DHEC has made a decision regarding the permit after consideration and complete review of the following: the permit application, applicable state and federal air quality regulations, comments made at the public meeting held on March 14, 2013, all comments received within the required time frame, and all other pertinent information. The written comment received was reviewed for technical merit and has been included in DHEC's permanent record for this facility. DHEC has concluded that the issues raised and comment made by the concerned citizen does not legally prevent issuance of the permit. Additionally, because the facility has demonstrated that it can comply with state and federal air quality regulations, DHEC is required by law to issue the requested permit. Therefore, DHEC's decision is to approve Air Quality Title V Operating Renewal Permit No. TV-1340-0002 for issuance on, Wednesday, April 17, 2013.
