In accordance with the provisions of the amended appeal process for DHEC decisions in 2006 Act No. 387, Section 44-1-60(D), and the 1976 Code of Laws of South Carolina, as amended, a Department Decision has been made to issue Air Quality Title V Operating Renewal Permit No. TV-1860-0038 to the above-named permittee. This permit was previously placed on public notice and open for public comment from July 21, 2010 through November 23, 2010. A public hearing was held by DHEC's Bureau of Air Quality (BAQ) on November 16, 2010, to receive oral and written comments on the proposed project. A Public comment was received by DHEC during the comment period. The Comment received during the formal comment period regarding air quality issues has been addressed in DHEC's *Responses to Comments on Air Quality* document attached to this Department Decision. DHEC's decision to issue this permit has been made after consideration and a complete review of the following: the air permit application, applicable state and federal air quality regulations, any comment received within the required time frame, the public hearing transcript, and all other pertinent information.

This Department Decision regarding Air Quality Title V Operating Renewal Permit No. TV-1860-0038 includes the following; a) the issued permit which meets the requirements of all applicable air quality regulations (Attachment A); b) The Statement of Basis which contains a summary of the project, applicable/non-applicable regulations and an explanation of the permit decision (Attachment B); c) the comment made by a concerned citizen and the response by the Bureau of Air Quality, as outlined in the Response to Comments (Attachment C) and This Department Decision (including attachments) will be included in DHEC's administrative record for this permit decision.
