Subject: CDC PPE Update

The following message is for the Healthcare Providers:

CDC has clarified its guidance regarding personal protective equipment (PPE) for healthcare personnel caring for suspected and confirmed Ebola patients in U.S. healthcare facilities. Based on feedback from healthcare facilities that have implemented the current guidance (originally posted October 2014), the updated guidance clarifies the use of fluid-resistant and impermeable gowns and coveralls. Specifications are provided in the guidance to assist facilities in selecting and ordering the recommended garments. In addition to clarifying the specifications of gowns and coveralls recommended, the PPE guidance for confirmed Ebola patients and clinically stable persons under investigation for Ebola has been updated with additional explanation.
