Screening Recommendations

Effective November 17th, 2014 the CDC and Department of Homeland Security added Mali to the list of Ebola-affected nations for which enhanced screening and monitoring measures will be implemented. The CDC now recommends that screening occurs for travel to Mali, as well as countries with ongoing widespread Ebola Virus Disease (EVD) transmission (Guinea, Liberia, or Sierra Leone) when assessing a patient with fever or other illness compatible with EVD.
