INTENT TO SOLE SOURCE

The South Carolina Department of Health and Environmental Control (DHEC) is seeking qualified vendors to provide auxiliary equipment for implementing a tandem mass spectrometry method for screening newborns for Pompe, MPS 1 and x-ALD conditions as recommended by the Secretary of the US Department of Health and Human Services. Equipment includes spectrometry bench, microplate incubator, 2-plate evaporator, 110volt air compressor, and Zephyr G3 enclosure. The auxiliary equipment must be compatible with a proposed Perkin Elmer Qsight 201 MD Screening System. This equipment is to be used in the DHEC Public Health Laboratory.
