Per the USACE's email request dated October 18, 2021, this letter is confirmation that DESC, [as the Applicant, and at the direction of the South Carolina Department of Health and Environmental Control (SCDHEC) and in accordance with the Voluntary Clean-up Contract (VCC) for the Huger St. former MGP Site, which was amended to include the Congaree River Project] does hereby confirm the following:

- Withdrawal of the sediment capping approach as verified by the USACE in correspondence dated October 18, 2017, with verification valid until March 18, 2022; and
- Replacement of the sediment capping approach with the Stakeholder Developed Modified Removal Action (SDMRA) [i.e., removal approach] as submitted in the Joint Federal and State Application dated September 28, 2020 and in accordance with subsequent additional and/or revised documents provided to the USACE in support of the removal action permit verification.

Based on DHEC's letter of concurrence, dated October 20, 2021, DESC requests that the USACE proceed with the MOA and authorization under Nationwide 38 to allow activities in the Congaree River to support the SDMRA as the preferred path forward and rescind the previous MOA and authorization for sediment capping activities in the Congaree River.
