South Carolina reported widespread activity this week. This is the ninth consecutive week at widespread activity.



Virologic Surveillance

This week there were **457** lab-confirmed tests reported. Influenza A was most frequently reported. In the current flu season, there have been **3322** lab-confirmed tests reported.



Influenza-Like Illness Surveillance The percent of patient visits to sentinel providers for an influenza-like illness (ILI) was 7.7%, which is above South Carolina's baseline (3.53%). The ILI activity level overall was high




Influenza-Associated Hospitalizations
This week 216 influenza-associated
hospitalizations were reported by 59 hospitals.
The cumulative hospitalization rate is 36.6 per
100,000. In the current flu season, there have
been 1840 influenza-associated hospitalizations.

Influenza-Associated Deaths
This week 9 influenza-associated deaths were reported; however, 3 deaths occurred during previous weeks. The cumulative mortality rate is 1.0 per 100,000. In the current flu season, there have been 52 influenza-associated deaths.

*Indicators for assessing influenza activity include: lab-confirmed tests, ILI percent, and hospitalizations.







Influenza-Like IIIness Surveillance

This week, the ILI activity level was high and 7.7% of patient visits to SC ILINet providers was attributed to an influenza-like illness. This is above the state baseline, 3.53%.

Reports were received from providers in 18 counties, representing all DHEC Public Health regions.

ILI percentage is dependent upon the number of reporting providers and/or can vary by disease activity or the number of providers submitting reports.
