Guide to Direct Purchase of Equipment and Materials — Equivalency

This guide provides information to assist project sponsors who procure, via direct purchase, equipment and materials for projects with equivalency requirements funded through the Clean Water State Revolving Fund (CWSRF) and the Drinking Water State Revolving Fund (DWSRF). A copy of the below documents for each direct purchase should be sent directly to the SRF project manager for review and approval.

SRF direct purchase of equipment and materials package:

- A copy of the equipment/material contract or purchase order is submitted for purposes of cost documentation;
- A letter from the Sponsor that its procurement code was followed for procuring the materials/equipment;
- Debar/EEO Letter (See Attachment B for example);
- Certification Regarding Debarment, Suspension, and Other Responsibility Matters (DHEC 3590);
- Bidder's Build America, Buy America Certification (DHEC 4360); unless the project has received a BABA waiver;
- Bidder's AIS Certification (DHEC 2556), applies to projects with a BABA waiver.

Please note that disbursement of funds related to direct purchase of equipment and materials will be withheld until the Project Sponsor has received approval of the direct purchase of equipment and materials package.
