Statewide Oral Health Needs Assessment 2022-2023



Step By Step Instructions for School-based Coordinators/ Nurses

A School-based Coordinator should be designated who will facilitate the **2022-23 South Carolina Oral Health Needs Assessment: Every Smile Counts** Survey. In most cases, the School Nurse serves as the School-based Coordinator.

- The School-based Coordinator should review the contents of box and distribute the following materials:
 - Every Smile Counts! Fact Sheet that provides a general overview of the statewide screening that is taking place. Copies of the Fact Sheet are provided for distribution to school personnel and parents/guardians
 - **Opt-out Forms** should be distributed to each K-5 and third grade teacher. The **Opt-out Forms** should be sent home to parents at least 1 week prior to the screening date.
 - Screening Results Forms should be distributed to classroom teachers. Teachers should add student names to forms prior to screening. These forms are brought to the screening and then sent home with students.
 - Educational materials for students should be distributed to the classes that are participating.
- The School-based Coordinator will follow up as needed to make sure the **Opt-out Forms** are distributed and collected in a timely manner. Any child who returns an Opt-out Form will <u>NOT</u> be screened.
- The School-based Coordinator will ask each K-5 and third grade teacher to complete the identification information on the **Screening Results Form** for each student. This includes the student's name and screening date. This **Screening Results Form** will be brought to the screening, completed and then sent home with the student.
- The School-based Coordinator will determine a location for the screenings to take place. Examples include: library, workroom, cafeteria or health room etc.
- The School-based Coordinator and teacher will confirm that students that return an **Opt-out Form** will not be screened.
- The School-based Coordinator will assist as needed in distributing student incentives to all students whether they were screened or not. This includes a toothbrush, educational coloring book and the **Screening Results Form.**
